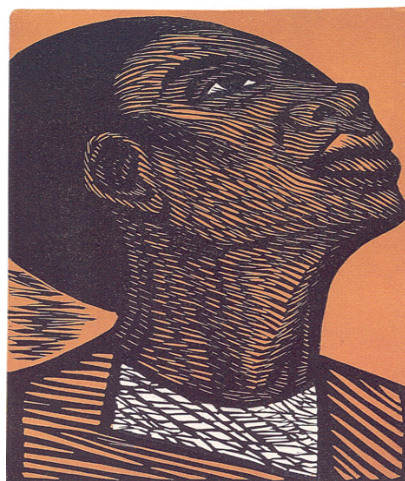

Feminist Studies 100WS Interdisciplinary 100WS

Learn about information resources and library services for **researching women's, feminist, and gender issues across the disciplines**.

The course is designed to teach students how to use library research tools critically and effectively. Emphasis will be placed on how to efficiently locate and assess academic and other useful information in specialized reference books, library catalogs, article databases, and digital archives. Thinking critically about women's studies scholarship, and the production, organization, and dissemination of scholarship is a central aspect of the course. INT/FEMST100WS will be most useful to students concurrently enrolled in a course requiring a significant research paper. Previous library research experience is not required. **Knowledge of women's, feminist, or gender issues is highly recommended.** Satisfies FEMST Area C requirement
